## MAN RAPES WOMAN AT COVID CENTRE IN PANVEL

Accused and victim are awaiting reports of their throat and nasal swab tests at the Covid Care Centre

The Panvel Taluka police have registered a case of molestation and rape against a 25-year-old man who allegedly sexually assaulted a 40-year-old woman at a COVID Care Centre in Panvel on Thursday night. While the incident happened in the evening, the victim woman informed the police at night.

The Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC) and Panvel Municipal Corporation (PMC) have kept people suspected of Coronavirus as well as those who have tested positive at the Covid Care Centre in Kon village, around 9 km from Panvel city.

The police said that the incident happened around 6.30 pm on Thursday. The woman informed others in the quarantine centre at around 11 pm. Both the accused and the victim are suspected of being infected with the Coronavirus.



They have both given their swab tests and are awaiting for their test results.

The victim was put on the fifth floor of the quarantine centre on July 15. The accused was quarantined on July 16 and provided accommodation on the second floor in the same wing of the COVID care centre.

Ashek Rajput, senior police inspector from Panvel Taluka police station said that the brother of the accused was found corona positive. The reason why the accused was also isolated at the quarantine centre. "The accused had brought food for his brother at the quarantine centre on July

15. However, by mistake, he knocked on the door of the woman. But apologised for his mistake," said Rajput.

However, on July 16 morning, the swab test report revealed that the accused man's brother is corona positive. "Since his brother tested positive, he too was put in the quarantine centre on July 16," said Rajput. He added that the accused had interacted with the victim once.

"In the evening around 6.30 pm, he knocked on the door of the woman. The woman thought it was a doctor who had come for a routine check-up. However, she was shocked to see him. He then sexually

assaulted the woman," said Rajput. He added that the woman did not tell anything at that time but informed others at around 11 pm. The accused is a resident of Sukhapur in Panvel.

The Panvel Taluka police registered an FIR against the accused under section 354 and 376 of IPC. "Since the accused is under treatment, he is staying there under security," said Rajput.

Sudhakar Deshmukh, municipal commissioner of PMC said that the civic administration will take precautionary measures after consultation with the police. "The incident is shocking for everyone. Nobody thought that a corona suspect would do such an act. Such actions demotivate people who are working day and night to save the infected person," said Deshmukh.

Meanwhile, the NMMC issued a statement after messages on social media claimed that NMMC had quarantined the woman. "NMMC has not accommodated any woman at the COVID care centre and message in circulation is wrong," said the statement.

## Nalasopara arms haul case: 2 seek interim bail

The two co-accused in the Nalasopara arms haul case, Ashwin Pawar and Liladhar Lodhi, recently sought temporary bail before a NIA special court. Pawar was the fifth to be arrested in the case in which 12 people are charged. He was arrested from Ghatkopar while Lodhi was arrested after a raid at his home in a village in Jalgaon.

They had been charged under various sections of the Explosive Substances Act, Explosives Act, Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, Arms Act and the Maharashtra Police Act. Vaibhav Raut was the first to be arrested in the case in August 2018 after a raid at his home in Nalasopara. He heads the Hindu Govansh Raksha Samiti, a cow-protection outfit. Four of his associates were also arrested for illegally storing explosives. During investigation more suspects were arrested and NIA had taken over the case from the ATS.

## PMC eases lockdown after demands pour in

The Panvel Municipal Corporation (PMC) has relaxed the lockdown after demands from citizens and public representatives poured in. The civic body issued a fresh circular on Friday and extended timing for keeping shops open, and also allowed a couple of more services during the lockdown. Now, vegetables and milk can be bought from the counter.

Residents had demanded that there should not be an extension of the lockdown after 10 days lockdown ended on July 13. Citizens are apprehensive that further extension of the lockdown will only deteriorate the economic conditions of the common people and the market. However, the civic body moved ahead with the decision and implemented a strict lockdown.

The political parties too joined the public and demanded that the lockdown should be lifted. Panvel MLA Prashant Thakur had written to the civic chief and request-



ed to lift the lockdown as this is affecting common people severely. "The economy cannot be kept suspended for a long time. The lockdown is affecting the business and trade. Despite all norms followed by the citizens, there is no control in the number of positive cases. Now, there is time to open the market so that people can get essentials easily," said Thakur.

Even, the Panvel Taluka Prashant Thakur had written to the civic chief and request-

middle-class people. Most of them used to earn daily to meet their needs," said Nitesh Sonawane, president of PTPSS.

As per the new circular, vegetables, fruits and non-veg shops can be kept open between 9 am to 5 pm while maintaining the social distancing. However, milk and dairy product shops can function between 5 am and 7 pm. Earlier, even these essential items were stopped to sell at the counter. Chemist shops are allowed till 9 pm and other medical emergencies are allowed 24 hours.

## MBMC sees 6,000+ cases, recovery touches 76.46%

MIRA-BHAYANDAR: With more than 4,645 patients cured of Covid-19 so far, the recovery rate has gradually increased to 76.46 per cent, even as the total count of cumulative positives breached the 6,000-mark on Thursday. The Mira-Bhayandar Municipal Corporation (MBMC) had registered 125 cases till Thursday night. With the latest addition, the number of positive cases has climbed to 6,075. On the bright side, 147 patients were discharged from hospital, taking the total number of

recoveries to 4,645 and bringing down the number of active cases to 1,217. The death toll climbed to 213.

As per official data, the MBMC has so far conducted 18,281 swab tests. However, those being tested have alleged that they are not getting reports on time, which not only leads to delay in treatment—especially close contacts of positive, symptomatic patients, but also enhances the risk of spread due to lack of proper monitoring.

## 'Copy Mumbai model' Deputy CM asks Pune & Pimpri Chinchwad civic bodies

Amidst rising coronavirus cases in Pune and Pimpri Chinchwad municipal corporation limits, Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar on Friday has asked the local authorities to set up jumbo facilities on the lines of Mumbai and put in place a computerised mechanism for the management of Covid-19 tests, doctors, ambulances and beds. Pawar invited BMC Commissioner Iqbal Chahal to share his experience including Mission Zero, Chase the Virus and establishment of Covid health care facilities including jumbo facilities for increasing the bed availability. Chahal's presentation comes against the backdrop of the emergence of Pune and Pimpri Chinchwad as corona epicentres and the spurt in cases is unabated. In Pune Municipal

Corporation jurisdiction the progressive Covid-19 positive cases have surged to 35,219 with 978 deaths while in Pimpri Chinchwad Municipal Corporation area 9,014 cases and 176 deaths as on date.

Chahal informed that the recovery rate in Mumbai is 70%. He also said the senior IAS officers have been deployed for the bed management in private hospitals while ward level war rooms have been set up to disseminate the information on the availability of beds and facilitate admission of Covid 19 patients.

Pawar asked the Pune district administration to emulate the Mumbai model in order to curb the further spread of coronavirus. He directed the administration for the strict implementation of Covid 19 containment strategy. The administration should make available necessary amenities at the institutional quarantine facilities.

## CAT WALK: Feline were found on the banks of Morna river at Patur, Akola on June 30 4 abandoned leopard cubs get fresh lease of life

Forest officials feed them with diluted goat's milk after their mother deserted them

A 15-day long operation to reunite leopard cubs with their mother, a diet of diluted goat's milk that sustained them for so long sans any infection or casualties, and finally the prospect of a life in captivity or semi-captivity. This is the story of the state forest department's long-drawn yet futile efforts to ensure that the cubs were finally in the care of their mother.

Vijay Mane, divisional forest officer, Akola territorial circle, said three leopard cubs had been found on the banks of the Morna river at Patur in Akola on June 30, and another the next day. The mother may have fled due to increased



human presence in the area. Of the four, two were male and the other two, female.

"We launched an exercise for 15 days to reunite the cubs with their mother. They were kept in the jungles, and the area was covered by camera traps and CCTVs. The female leopard would come, reconnoiter the area, and leave without taking her cubs. This happened for eight to 10 days. A couple of days ago, she came around 10 meters close to her offspring, but did not accept them. She responded to the mating call of a male leopard and left," he explained.

Meanwhile, based on advice of veterinarians, the cubs were reared on a diet



of diluted goat milk. This ensured that they were healthy and did not suffer from any casualties or infections. Rescued cubs and fed diluted goat or cow milk, or in case they develop any infections, powered milk is included in their diet.

The cubs were finally dispatched to the department's rescue centre at Gorewadi in Nagpur.

Principal chief conservator of forests (wildlife) Nitin Kakodkar said the cubs could not be released into their natural habitat without their mother. Another forest official

said that while the behaviour of the mother who refused to accept her rescued cubs was unusual, animal ecology was difficult to decipher. He added that there was a chance that these cubs would be reared in captivity and not released into the wild. "It makes sense to go in for a release of only those species which have a conservation value, like vultures and lesser floricans. Leopards are found in abundance. They may attack humans and cause conflict as they have a strong human imprint during their captivity," he added.
